Patrol:

Scott Ames reported that a dissolved oxygen meter had been purchased for under \$200. The first sample was taken with the meter and results were typical of what was measured at the lab.

Paul Behuniak reported the harvester is ready to go but would need fuel. Stan Ptak is ready to start cutting. It was suggested to hire Mark Kennedy as well to back Stan up and to operate the dump truck.

Vessels and Equipment:

Paul Behuniak reported a prop had to be replaced on one of the patrol boats. John Annino reported that dock lines were missing from the boats and needed replacing. Mike Stahl said he would replace the lines.
