Weed Harvester:

Paul Behuniak reported that all repairs were made on the harvester and it is in the water ready for use.

Vessels and Equipment:

Paul Behuniak reported that the dock finger was in the water but the water was too low to put the dock in yet. The boats were cleaned but needed to have the batteries installed yet. The upgraded beacon lights would be installed by Monday.
