Patrol:

Edward Baclawski, the Assistant LHAMP Chief, reported that the season has started out well with no notable issues other than mechanical issues with the boats.

Dave Zitnay commented that the placement of the boats during the regatta was not optimal. It was noted that it was partially impacted by one of the boats having a damaged prop. Sandy Blanchard extended a thank you to the LHAMP on behalf of the NHRC for their help.

Water Quality:

Scott Ames reported that the first sample was taken last month and the results came back typical. The next sample will be taken next week.

Weed Harvester:

Paul Behuniak reported that all the hydraulic hoses were replaced on the weed harvester from the front to the back.

Vessels and Equipment:

Paul Behuniak reported there were several instances of mechanical damage to the patrol boats. The starter and flywheel were damaged when the boat was shifted from forward to reverse without pausing at neural while the boat was traveling at approximately 40mph. The ignition switch was damaged. A prop was damaged from traveling into a known shallow area.
