Patrol:

Jim Olson reported that all permits have been applied for. Similar acreage as last year. Two applications. Targeting mid-July for tape grass and first week of August for Milfoil.

Vessels and Equipment:

Jim Olson reported that the weed abatement contractor Solitude has agreed to purchase the weed harvester for \$4,000. He asked the board to make a motion to accept the offer and apply the purchase price to the weed abatement bill.
