Patrol:

Chief Brainard reported that training would not be available for new officers for 2022. Neither the plan to try to piggyback training efforts with the Park Rangers nor to get training just for the LHA were successful. The LHA's Lake Sargent was promoted and is no longer in our region so there is a good chance he will be replaced this year.

Water Quality: No report at this time.

Weed abatement:

Jim Olson reported that the current permit was for a duration of 3 years so no new permits will be needed for this year or next year. Jim said he would continue to work with the weed abatement vendor Solitude to fine tune the treatment. Overall, the Milfoil treatment is working well but not the tape grass. Last year was difficult due to rain and high-water levels causing treatments to be rescheduled and to not be able to keep minimal flow for adequate time after treatment. Jim noted he is pursuing grants to potentially help offset the cost of or expand on the current treatment plans and studies.

Vessels and Equipment: No report at this time.
