Water Quality:

Scott Ames reported the first sample of the season was taken and results were typical to prior years. The second sample will be collected next week.

Weed abatement:

Jim Olson reported that the first weed treatment would be July 17th and the second would be August 4th. He asked that the secretary post the date son Facebook for public awareness. He also asked the Chairman to contact the Derby Rec Camp to inform them as well.

The permits were not complete yet but there were no issues expected. He is working on a quote for two days of mechanical weed harvesting in a couple trouble spots that aren't responding to weed treatment.

Vessels and Equipment:

The Chairman asked that the patrol be remined to put the motors up on the boats when docked to keep zebra mussels from collecting in the lower units. There are currently 390hours on the black boat and 367 hours on the blue boat. The board will consider replacing the boats and motors in the next 2 years.
